

Pesticides: Label Information

Demonstration

Prep Time: About an hour to assemble materials

Works Well With: Groups of about 8 to 12 employees.

Needed Materials: Pesticide label information and multiple sets of PPE.

Suggestion: Use this exercise to demonstrate how pesticide label information is to be used to select appropriate PPE.

This exercise is appropriate for groups of handlers and workers who are involved in early-entry activities.

Start by covering the information on the pesticide's label. Make sure the group understands the product's hazards and the precautions they are to take. It would be best if each trainee had a handout of the label's information to refer to during the exercise. Have the trainees take turns finding certain types of information on the label, and have them read it to the group.

Divide the group into two or more teams and have them use the label information to select appropriate PPE from the supply you've brought to class.

Make sure each team has selected all the PPE that would be needed for the job.

Ask a volunteer from each group to demonstrate how the PPE is to be put on, adjusted, worn, removed, and decontaminated.
