Intervene -Pull the victim out of the interaction using an excuse or a similar distraction.

Direct -Speak directly with the harasser, especially if you think it was unintentional and you're concerned about potentially harsh consequences of an official complaint.

Elevate -Ask for help from management if a confrontation makes you too uncomfortable, or request a meeting with a representative from Human Resources if harassment involves someone in management above you.

Approach -Speak with the victim after the fact, and offer your support.
